O Almighty God, Who art a strong tower of defence unto thy servants against the face of their enemies; we yield thee praise and thanksgiving for our deliverance from those great dangers wherewith we were compassed: We acknowledge it Thy goodness that we were not delivered over as thy prey to them; beseeching Thee still to continue such Thy mercies towards us, that all the world may know that Thou art our Saviour and Mighty Deliverer; through Jesus Christ our Lord.
